From a visit from one of my first international students from the early 90s with her grown children to a Christmas play put on by students from many continents, God is faithful! We had great discussions of our Idioms, Proverbs, and Parables studies where we discussed a parable of Jesus at our dinners. A local church hosted a square dance where the students experienced the love of Christ from strangers (but not for long!). Without a City Director, our volunteers have been incredible! So grateful for God's provision.

The highlight of the year was our Christmas party. One of the host church members had bought cookies and candy for Christmas for seniors, but the home said she couldn't give them. But God connected the right people and she ended up giving them as presents to our students! We were able to give them an ornament with the true meaning of Christmas explained with some other things, and all of them were touched by the generosity of new and old friends. We read the Christmas story once and then provided costumes for the students to act it out while we read it again. It was moving to see an international holy family and other cast members! All were enthusiastic and many really got into their part! But the important thing is they heard the Scriptures and how Jesus came to our world. We ended the night with a snowball fight, which helped relieve the stress many of them were feeling with finals looming.
