Mission Moment

Trinity Church has partnered with Alberto Leiva and YFC Nicaragua since 2010. Alberto's ministry focuses on reaching young men and women in the middle and high schools of Esteli. He is also involved with bringing various protestant churches together in a united ministry for youth and adults. This effort is more important as Nicaragua becomes more politically and socially divided.

UNHCR spokesperson Shabia Mantoo gave this summary of the situation in Nicaragua on March 10. "Nearly two years after Nicaragua was plunged into a serious political and social crisis, more than 100,000 people have fled reported persecution and human rights abuses in the country, seeking asylum abroad.

Even after the initial surge of violence in April 2018 subsided, Nicaraguan students, human rights defenders, journalists and farmers continue to flee their country at an average rate of 4,000 people every month. With no resolution to the internal crisis in sight, UNHCR, the UN Refugee Agency, expects these numbers to grow."

In 2018 at the request of Nicaraguan opposition leaders the United States imposed trade restriction on Nicaragua that have crippled the economy. There are few import goods available. People have lost jobs in the textile and meat production businesses that are strategic world trade. Prices have risen dramatically.


Because of these challenges Alberto and his family are unable to afford the rent of their modest home and YFC center. The home features a small kitchen and gathering space used for worship, teaching, and fellowship. The Mission Team has recommended that Trinity Church step up for one year with an additional \$200 gift that would secure their ministry in their home.

Trinity supports 15 missionaries and mission projects in the U.S. and around the world. Our current total financial commitment is \$2,550 per month to these partners. Additional help to Alberto would add \$2400 to that amount. Average giving per month in 2020 has been \$1650. These are challenging financial times in the U.S. But with God's help, we can meet these challenges.
