Mission Moment

Each spring Trinity Church partners with Feed the Hunger to help feed the spiritual and physical huger of people around the world by hosting a Packathon. A Packathon is a food packing event in which volunteers package fully nutritious meals for children in FtH-established programs in America, Haiti, Kenya, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, and Jamaica. Each meal costs \$0.28. At our last Packathon, Trinity Church members and friends packed 10,000 meals with donations of \$2,800.

Several years ago a mission team from Trinity traveled to Haiti to join the national partners in distributing food. Our team worked with Pastor Maxeau Antoine during the week and we joined his church for worship on Sunday. This testimony of CEO Joseph Williams from the last FtH newsletter caught my attention.

"We were visiting a children's home in Port au prince, Haiti, where 30 girls live ranging in age from 10-21...At one point, our ministry partner, Pastor Maxeau, asked if any of the girls wanted to share their favorite Bible verse. One girl quoted Psalm 27:10, and it stopped me in my tracks. I had to know why someone would choose this particular verse..."It says, "though my father and mother forsake me, the Lord will receive me."

After our informal time with the young ladies was over, I told Pastor Maxeau I wanted to speak to this girl. Her name was Misca. I had to know why she would choose such a verse. She replied she had lost both of her parents in the devastating earthquake of January 12, 2010.

It was a blessing to help someone like Misca and to come alongside a Christian children's home where she and the other girls have embraced God. Pray for the continued provision of nutritious food and Bibles that will help them grow and change their country for the better."

Through your gifts and participation in the Trinity Mission program, our church is making an impact in the needlest parts of the world.
