Congregational Meeting: There will be a Congregational Meeting on Sunday morning January 12 at 9:30 AM to vote on passage of proposed Bylaws. Trinity's Bylaws were rewritten last year to streamline the function of our elder board and ministry teams. The proposed bylaws also were written to improve clarity in procedure. There are no substantive changes proposed to congregational life or doctrine. The proposed Bylaws and an Addendum explaining the church's foundational theological positions are available on the Trinity Church website or in hard copy through the church office. Our Articles of Incorporation require a 2/3 majority vote of active membership for acceptance of the proposed By Laws. We will need at least 95 persons to attend and vote for the measure. Mission Moment

President of Alaska Christian College (ACC) Keith Hamilton visited Trinity Church on Saturday, November 23. Those attending were challenged by his report.

Alaska ranks 2nd to last in the nation for the number of freshmen students who graduate with a Bachelor's degree within six years of beginning their undergraduate track. The transition from a subsistence life style to an urban experience is difficult for most students raised in traditional families and environments.

ACC students face tough odds; in Alaska the numbers are staggering. Out of the 100 students who start the 9^{th} grade, 33 will go to college, only 10 will graduate within 6 years.

ACC is the only Christian institution of higher education focused on serving Alaska natives. Its mission is to empower Alaska Natives through Biblically based higher education and Christian formation to pursue excellence in character, learning, and service as followers of Christ.

The vision of ACC is to be the premier college of choice for Alaska Native students so that its graduates follow and serve Christ within the church and larger society.

God is blessing the work! The largest class since its inception in 2000 gathered this fall; over 100 students are enrolled. The facilities are expanding. Land has been purchased and ground has been broken for the construction of a new athletic center.
