Dear Praying Partners - Thanks SO much for your prayers for us and all involved in discipleship around us.

For our organizational meeting with the youth from our neighborhood who attended camp we had almost a 100 % turnout...20 out of 21 - praise God! They asked that we plan on Saturday afternoon gatherings so we will be meeting with them again this afternoon. While looking through the mission bookstore inventory earlier this week I was delighted to find a booklet in Lingala written JUST FOR TEENS! It has about a dozen lessons on the basics of following Jesus. I showed it to Dir. Pasi and Disciple Ngando and they want to go ahead and use it for short teaching times at youth group.

Please pray: Not all of the kids have good reading/writing skills so we don't want to embarrass them. May we be sensitive in our presentation of the material so no one will be 'put off' and stop coming. May the Holy Spirit use it to help them grow in their knowledge and commitment to Christ.

Please pray for Remy. He is 16 and the son of good frienda of ours. Remy had a tough time this past year. He'd been acting out so much at school that his father made him sit out this past year. (It is a big sacrifice on the family to come up with the money to cover school fees and other costs.) "Ma" Marie, Dir. Pasi's wife, cajoled Remy into coming to camp this year. There he prayed to receive Christ and testified at campfire. I'm so glad he came to the first youth meeting but he sat broodily through the whole time together and did not respond much.
